**NOTE**

1. The work costing more than Rs. 5 Crore or work involving specialized skill and STPs shall be got executed by eligibility criteria as per concerned tender document, which will be open to all eligible contractors/firms.
2. Graduate Engineer, shall be eligible for enlistment in class III without fulfilling any other requirement except enlistment fees. Higher class enlistment shall be as per specified eligibility criteria of that class.
3. The Inspection/recommendation committee shall be constituted by concerned Chief Engineer for Class -I and by concerned Superintending Engineer for Class -II, III & IV. For enlistment under Class -I, Director (Planning & Design) will convene the meeting as and when required.
4. Works completed and Commissioned during last five years shall only be considered for Criteria.
5. PWSSB reserves its right to adopt eligibility criteria for the works costing more than 5 Crore, as decided from time to time.

**Subject: Review Meeting by Chief Executive Officer, Punjab Water Supply & Sewerage Board with PWSSB Contractors Association Punjab.**

A meeting was held under the Chairmanship of Chief Executive Officer, Punjab Water Supply & Sewerage Board with PWSSB Contractors Association Punjab on 07.09.2015 following issues were discussed:-

**Sr. Issues discussed**

**No.**

**1 Review of New Enlistment Criteria**

Contractor Association explained problems regarding enlistment of previously enlisted contractors. They explained that now circulated enlistment criteria is very stringent and even agencies enlisted previously are not eligible for enlistment. After due consideration it was decided that for already enlisted contractors the eligibility criteria may be amended for Water Supply & Sewerage works only. Amended criteria is as below:-

**For Class-I**

Three completed contracts of Rs. 1.00 Cr. in respective category or  
Two completed contracts of Rs. 1.50 Cr. in respective category or  
single completed contract of Rs. 3.00 Cr. in respective category.

**OR**

Completed contracts of total cost Rs. 3.00 Cr. (works upto four No. & costing more than Rs. 0.60 Cr. in respective category will only be considered).

**OR**

One Completed Contract of Civil Engineering of Rs.4.00 Cr.

**OR**

Two Completed Contracts of Civil Engineering of Rs.2.50 Cr.

**OR**

Three Completed Contracts of Civil Engineering of Rs.2.00 Cr.

**For Class-II**

Three Completed Contracts of Rs. 0.40 Cr. in respective category or  
two completed contracts of Rs. 0.60 Cr. in respective category or single  
completed contract of Rs. 1.20 Cr. in respective category.

**OR**

Completed contracts of total cost Rs. 1.20 Cr. (works upto four No. & costing more than Rs. 0.20 Cr. in respective category will only be considered).

**OR**

One Completed Contract of Civil Engineering of Rs.1.60 Cr.

**OR**

Two Completed Contract of Civil Engineering of 1.00 Cr.

**OR**

Three Completed Contract of Civil Engineering of Rs.0.80 Cr.

**For Class-III**

Three completed contracts of Rs. 10.00 lac in respective category or  
two completed contracts of Rs. 15.00 lac in respective category or  
single completed contract of Rs. 30.00 lacs in respective category.

**OR**

Completed contracts of total cost Rs. 30.00 lacs (works upto four No. & costing more than Rs. 7.50 lacs in respective category will only be considered).

For Class-IV

Three contract Agreement of Rs. 2.00 lac in respective category.

(Revised eligibility criteria placed below)

2 **Regarding Checking of Final Bills from Quality Control Cell**

Contractor Association demanded that since all works are checked by Quality Control Cell at the time of execution. Even all running bills are also checked by another sub divisional engineer in addition to in charge sub divisional engineer. They also told that their final bills remain pending for long time and due to this their final securities also are held up. It was decided that a time bound period for payment of all bills will be issued, after due consultation with all Chief Engineers.

3 **Regarding Allotment of Works to Co-operative Societies**

Contractor Association expressed their resentment that works are allotted to co-operative societies which are not enlisted in PWSSB. They desired that since works of board are skilled in nature so societies should not be allowed to tender. It was explained that as per policy of Govt., societies are eligible to tender. Even then if they feel any grievance, they can make their representation to Govt.

4 **Regarding Composite Tenders.**

Contractors Association expressed their resentment that since tenders are being invited for cluster and they being not eligible for these tenders so they will be without work or will have to work under them as sub contractors.

It was explained that it is as per policy of gov. to provide better facilities to public so tender of Water Supply, Sewerage, Roads, Street Lights including Operation & Maintenance for 10 years are being invited.
