

# More CAPF companies rushed to Manipur; NIA to probe killing of six

**NEW DELHI, NOVEMBER 22** An additional 90 companies of paramilitary forces will be deployed in Manipur, the state government's security adviser Kuldip Singh said after holding a high-level meeting with the Army and paramilitary forces on Friday evening.

Singh said these 90 companies will be sent as reinforcements in addition to the 106 forces already stationed in the state, thus taking the overall tally of these forces to 206. Some of these reinforcements have already reached Imphal.

He added, "The decision was taken after holding a security review meeting with state DGP representatives of Army, CRPF, BSF, ITBP and Assam Rifles, the security adviser further informed.

"We held a review meeting of all the districts of the state and discussed and shared all the issues and noted concerns of the districts SPs. We are getting 90 additional companies over and above the 106 which are already there," Singh said. He added forces will be distributed in vulnerable districts and in addition to that, district coordination cells will be created along with control rooms. Banning of control mechanisms, fringe area protection, and force deployment were reviewed and upgraded. The

authorities are monitoring highways to ensure smooth functioning and safeguarding fringe areas that are prone to disturbances, Singh said.

Responding to a query, he said as many as 268 people have been killed in the ethnic conflict which started in the state in May 2023 and operations are still going on. Till now, 3,000 weapons have been recovered. This development

# 10 Naxals killed in C'garh encounter

**IMPHAL, NOVEMBER 22** Ten Naxalites, three of them women, were gunned down in an encounter with security personnel in Chitragarh, a Sukma district on Friday, a senior police official said.

CM Vishnu Dev Singh hailed the security forces and said the team of security personnel who took part in the encounter had returned to the Restar region. The fight broke out in the morning in a forest near Chitragarh village in the Sukma district. Two of the deceased have been identified as Madhukar Mass (42), military in-charge of the south Restar district of Mandla and Lakshma Madvi, an IAS committee member. The IAS said, adding that they were carrying a bounty of Rs 8 lakh and Rs 5 lakh, respectively. — PTI

# PM Modi back, met 31 world leaders during 3-nation tour

**NEW DELHI, NOVEMBER 22** PM Narendra Modi was back in India on Friday after his three-nation tour of Nigeria, Brazil and Guyana. The PM met 31 world leaders and heads of government during his five-day travel, which was marked by a flurry of bilateral meetings.

Official sources said Modi participated in 31 bilateral meetings and informal interactions with global leaders during his visit. He held one bilateral meeting in Nigeria and 10 bilateral meetings on the sidelines of the G20 Summit in Brazil. Thereafter, during the visit to Guyana, he held nine bilateral meetings.

**NEW DELHI, NOVEMBER 22** BJP leader Vinod Tawde on Friday sent defamation notices to top leaders of the Opposition, demanding an apology or hefty damages for leveling cash-for-vote charges against him.

In the notice to Congress MP Anshu Kharage, Tawde said they had leveled false and baseless allegations against him and damaged his reputation. He said if they did not apologise to him in 24 hours, he would move court and seek Rs 100 crore in damages. Tawde was accused of distributing Rs 5 crore to two party members.

**10 bilateral meetings on G20 sidelines**

They added that among the 31 bilateral meetings in Brazil, the first was with Prabowo Subianto, President of Indonesia. Later, Modi met with the leaders of Guyana, Dominican Republic, Barbados, St. Vincent and the Grenadines, and St. Lucia.
